HIGH PRIORITY IDEAS AND VALUES



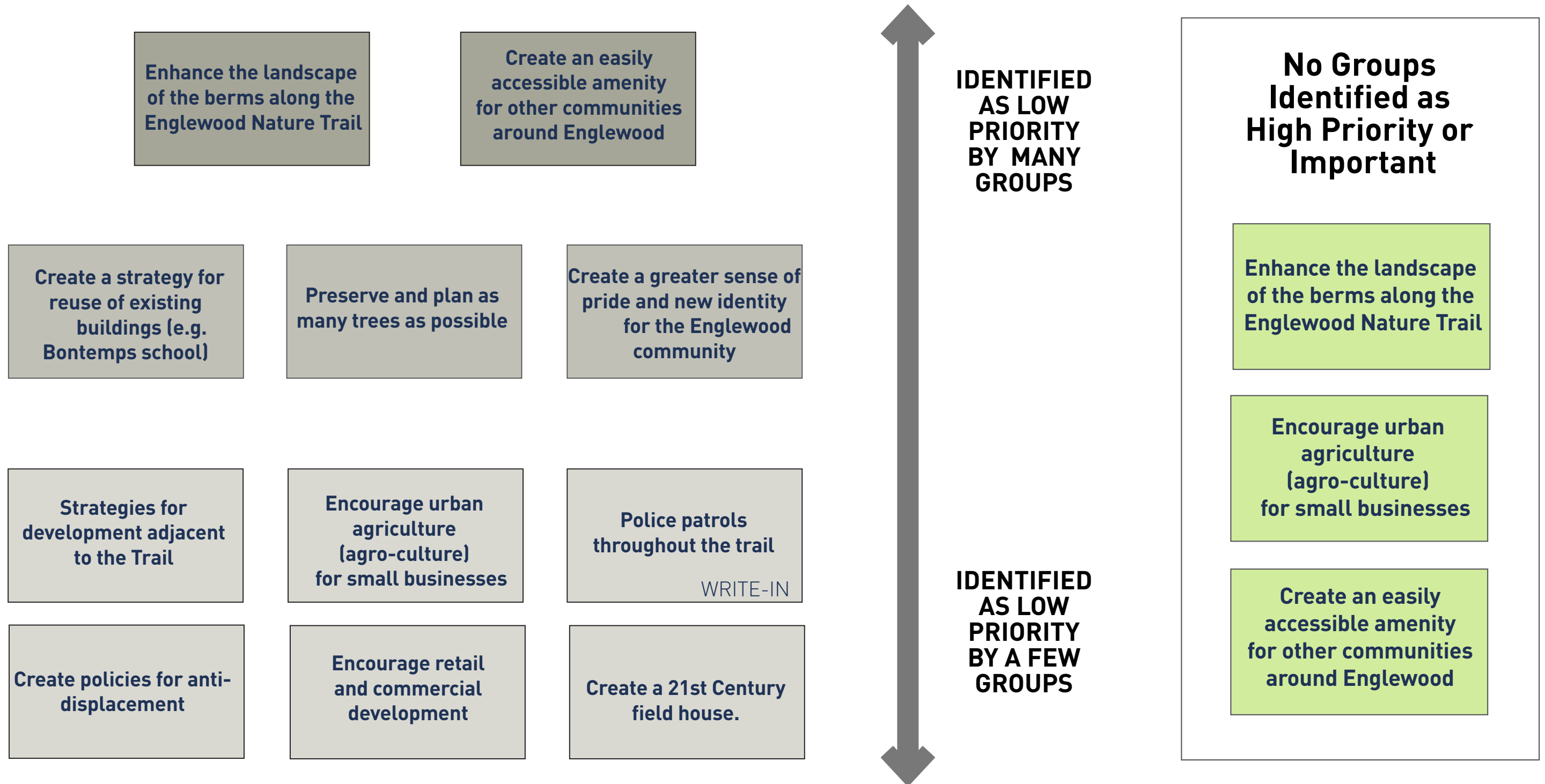
HIGH PRIORITY + IMPORTANT IDEAS AND VALUES

5. Provide a place for Englewood residents to heal, play, celebrate, and grow.

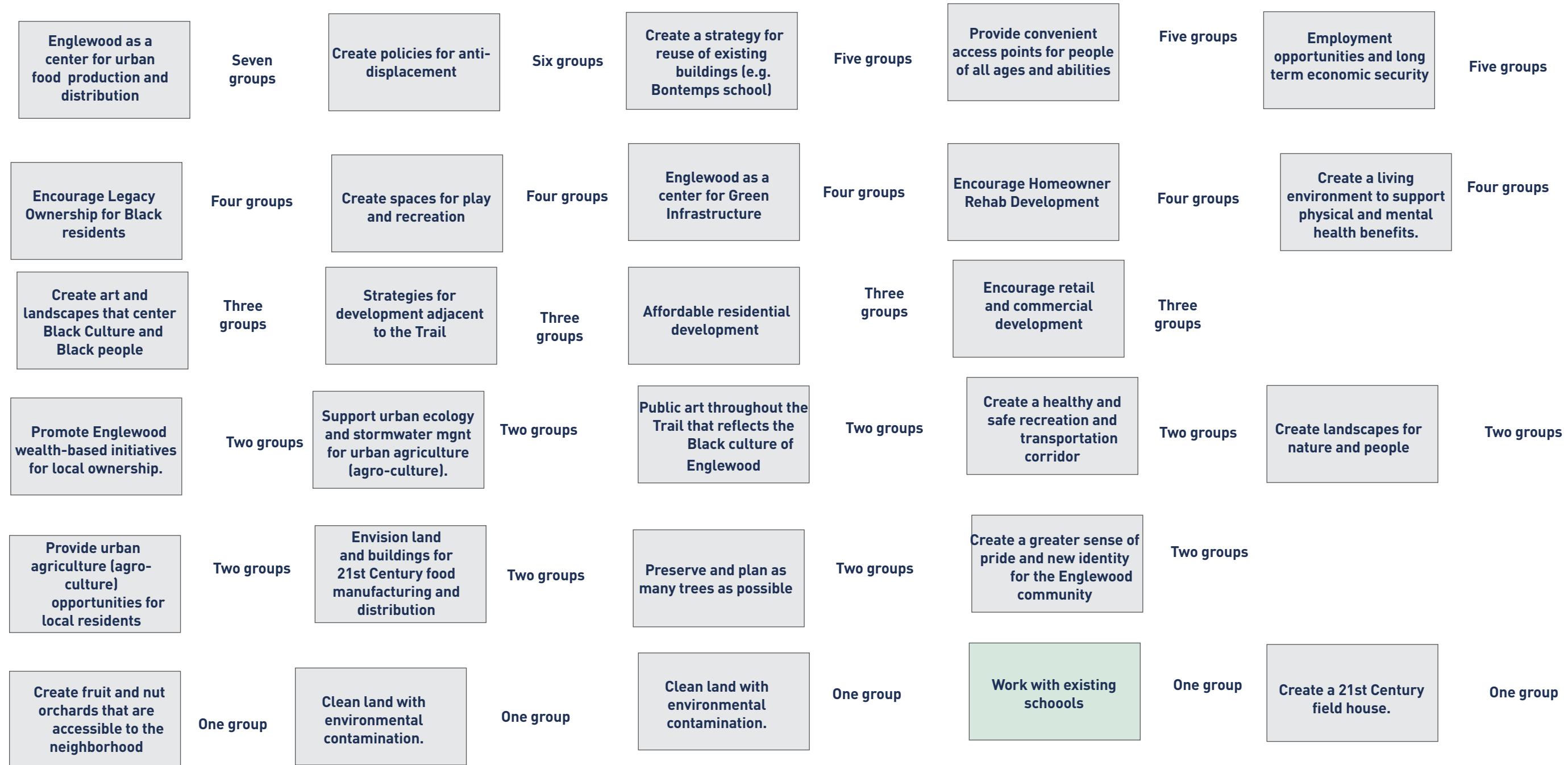
